1. If parents are not married the name of the Father may be indicated only if proof of paternity if established by a legal document or by written testimony of the Father sworn before two witnesses. (Such documentation must be retained with Baptismal record.)
2. Only a legal domicile within the parish territory is needed to be a proper subject (cc. 101-103: 105-107).
3. Only One godparent is required; but if two are designated the must be opposite genders.
4. If the proposed godparent is Not Catholic or Not confirmed she/he may not assume the role (but confer n, 5 below).
5. Only a validly baptized Christian may take the place of One Catholic godparent (without reference to gender).
